### **Flint Public Art Competition Call for Entries!**



The AIA Flint and Flint Public Art Project announce the first annual Flat Lot Competition, a program to design and build a temporary summer pavilion in the central parking lot in downtown Flint.

The Flat Lot Competition transforms a surface parking lot at the center of downtown Flint into a dynamic public space. Winning entries will receive \$25,000 to design and build an innovative temporary structure that serves as a staging ground for concerts, parades, car shows, running races, and other events. The Flat Lot Competition will demonstrate the capacity of contemporary architectural form-making to create new experiences of space and amplify the many existing activities that help define public life in Flint.

### **S. Glen Paulsen: 1917-2012**

Bloomfield Hills, Michigan, November 30, 2012 - S. Glen Paulsen, one of the three original founding members of TMP Architecture, Inc., passed away on Sunday, November 25th. He was 95 years old.

Paulsen joined the office of Eero Saarinen in 1949 and worked as an associate and senior designer until 1957, when he established his own firm. He began teaching at the University of Michigan Taubman College of Architecture and Urban Planning that same year and continued to teach there for many years. Paulsen was also involved at the Cranbrook Academy of Art and ultimately served as President of the academy from 1966-1970 while continuing as head of the architecture studio and operating Glen Paulsen and Associates.

GPA merged with Tarapata, MacMahon Associates of Bloomfield Hills in 1969, becoming TMP Architecture, Inc. In addition to his work and teaching endeavors, Glen was pleased to be a member of the Michigan Society of Architects and an AIA Fellow.

Glen was a natural mentor. It was gratifying to him that many of the men and women he taught and mentored kept in touch with him throughout their careers. Their letters, calls, and visits gave him a great deal of pleasure.

**Glen's memorial service will be held at the First United Methodist Church, 128 Park St., Chelsea, Michigan 48118, on December 8, 2012, at 2 pm.** A reception will follow the service.

Glen was focused on leaving a legacy to help the educational institutions he loved.
