The States Board of Architects rules requiring Michigan architects to obtain 12 hours of Health, Safety and Welfare credits annually for licensing renewal is moving through the administrative approval process. It is our best estimate that architects will need to start collecting credits on November 1, 2014. Yes, AIA HSW credits are acceptable for relicensing. Once the new rules procedures are concluded, we will inform our members.
