AIA Michigan Design Award Winners!

We are very excited for this week because after a LONG wait, we have gotten word from the jury and can officially announce the winners of the 2013 AIA Michigan Design Awards! We have not even had the chance to notify the winners individually yet but we know the membership has been waiting for this news and we wanted to get the information out as soon as possible.

The **Building Award** was granted to the following entries: "Bagley Avenue Pedestrian Bridge"; "Laketown Residence" from Allegretti Architects; "Michigan State University Language Arts Building" from Hamilton Anderson Associates and IDS; "Eli and Edythe Broad Art Museum" from IDS and Hamilton Anderson Associates Landscape Architects; the "Mixed Use Educational Facility" (A. Alfred Taubman Center for Design Education at CCS in Detroit) from Albert Kahn Associates, Inc; the "John Ball Zoo Treehouse" from Progressive AE; and the "Ottawa Street Power Station Rehabilitation" project from Ouinn Evans Architects.

The **Low Budget/Small Project Award** went to the "126K House" by Paul Urbanek, FAIA and the "Ludwig Residence" submitted by McIntosh Poris Associates.

The **Steel Award** will be presented to IDS for the "Robert B. Aikens Commons".

There were three **Unbuilt** project winners chosen: the SmithGroupJJR "Memorial", "A Dozen Playgrounds" from MAde Studio, and "Washtenaw Country East Side Recreation Center" by Ply Architecture (Craig Borum, AIA).

This year, the **25 Year Award** will honor Robert Ziegelman, FAIA for his Azars Oriental Rugs building.

The Recognitions Awards have been decided as well. This year we honor two **Young Architect Award** winners: Matt Taylor, AIA and Jeffrey Johnson, AIA, and we have two **Honorary Affiliate Members**: Lynne Merrill-Francis, Hon. Aff. AIAMI and Michelle Saroki, Hon. Aff. AIAMI. The 2013 **Firm of the Year** Award will be presented to SmithGroupJJR at the ceremony in June.

Our members made us proud with their committment and contributions and the following awards have rightly been bestowed on: Fred Butters, FAIA (Robert F. Hastings Award), Paul Goldsmith (President's Award), Gary Quesada, Hon. Aff. AIAMI (Balthazar Korab Award), Art Smith, FAIA (Gold Medal) and Amanda Harrell-Seyburn, Assoc. What Does AIA National Actually Do?

Not many of AIA National undertakings and activities are clearly communicated and filtered to the state and local levels, leaving component chapters to wonder what AIA National does with all the dues AIA National collects each year! In order to better communicate AIA National initiatives to our membership, we will feature a category from the 2012 Accomplishments publication AIA National released at AIA National Grassroots in March.

This week we are featuring the "**Growing Our Commitment**" category, which has five main focus areas under the umbrella topic of "Sustainability":

2030 Commitment:

AIA firm participation in the energy efficiency and building performance program increased, growing by 20 percent in the past two years. Nearly a quarter of participating firms have less than 10 employees, and the gross square footage firms reported that were designed using the 2030 Commitment principles saw a 70% increase from 2010.

Trends:

The AIA's guide to the new International Green Construction Code and its Energy Modeling Guide, both released in 2012, will keep members informed and up to speed on essential shifts in the profession at the same time that the number of signatories to the 2030 Commitment continued to grow.

Digital:

The Energy Modeling Guide achieved 28,500 downloads in five weeks exceeding a year-end goal of 20,000. The AIA Guide to the IgCC achieved 100,000 downloads in 2012.

Green

AIA Contract Documents launched Sustainable Projects (SP) documents at the convention to recognize how green design is transforming practice-all of which were available in v4. 6 of the desktop software.

Rebuilding:

AIA Legacy, the AIA's 501c3 foundation, created a Regional Comprehensive Development Plan for Cap-Haïtien, Haiti's second largest city, to help the country address current and future rebuilding following the devastation of the earthquake of 2010. The effort, sponsored by the Inter- American Development Bank and United States Agency for International Development/ Office of Transition Initiatives, is centered in a region known as "the birthplace of a Haiti." The Comprehensive Plan will be made public in 2013
