47th Michigan Health Facilities Planning Seminar - 2014 **Project Presentation**

Call for Entries Due Date: Wednesday, February 5, 2014

The Michigan Health Facilities Planning Seminar Project Presentation Subcommittee is seeking submittals for our 47th Seminar scheduled for Thursday & Enday, March 20th & 21st, 2014 at the Grand Traverse Resort in Traverse City, Michigan.

Because the presentation of projects continues to be a resounding success, we are again offering this opportunity to highlight the leading edge of design work being done by Michigan Architects. As always, your participation is needed to make this feature a continued success.

This year we are again requesting that the review submittal be in electronic PDF format.

What is new this year is that the **final approved project presentation will be included in electronic format** on the seminar website for viewing. You will also be allowed to cisplay a penel of the <u>approved</u> project page at the seminar.

All panels must be made from half (1/2) inch thick foam board (Gatorboard), 24" x 24" in size. It will be your responsibility to transport the panels to the seminar location. Easels will be provided for the display of the panels.

There will no longer be the need to submit 400 printed copies as required in the past, saving printing costs and minimizing environmental impact.

The Criteria for Submittal Is:

- A \$200.00 submission fee payable by check, money order or credit card, is required for each PDF formatted. A \$200.00 submission fee, payade by check, money order or credit card, is required for each PDF formatted, project file submitted for approval. If submitted <u>after the Due Date</u>, an added <u>\$100.00 late submission fee</u> will be required for each project page. The submitting Archited trachtheturus I limm **must be** ilterset to do work in Michigan. The Project must have been completed or occupied no earlier than January 2003. If under construction, the project must be scheduled for occupancy by Desember 2014. We wish to stress that each of these project files is to be garared to the presentation of <u>ONE, INDIVIDUAL</u>, health care project. It is NOT the committee's intert or desire that these be general advertisements for each firm. Multiple listings of projects per Architect/Architectural Firm will be permitted. The origination of <u>three</u> projects per Architect/ArchitectUral Firm will be permitted.

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- The orientation of the page must be in <u>landscape</u> format. Calor or black and white graphics is at your option. The project lie must indue the project information noted as 'required' on the submittal form **Please limit the size of the PDF file to 5MB**.
