AIAMI Design Awards: Call for Entries!

Architects across the state of Michigan are invited to submit their best work for consideration in a juried design awards program. This prestigious competition has, for over 48 years, sought to honor and embrace the creativity, diversity and architectural excellence of Michigan architects. Members are encouraged to nominate individuals whose accomplishments have helped to foster healthy, safe and sustainable communities through good design.

Grassroots: Travel Stipends Available!

This travel stipend was created to provide monetary assistance to component leaders and component executives who would not be able to attend Grassroots without some financial support. The AIA believes that the investment to support our leaders is a crucial part of its mission. Due to budgetary constraints, assistance will not be afforded to all components but every effort will be made to help as many components as possible. First priority will be given to components that haven't been able to send any of their leaders to Grassroots for the past three years.

Consideration will also be given to components that can only afford to send one of their leaders.

The AIA will provide one-to-one matching funds, not to exceed \$1,000 per person, for only one individual per component. If you are unable to provide any funding for a component leader to attend, please indicate this on the application form.

Small Business Tax Break Notice

The State of Michigan has made significant changes regarding personal property taxes. Beginning December 31, 2013 eligible personal property is exempt from taxation if the "true cash value" of the property is less than \$80,000. This exemption affidavit must be **filed by February 10th**.

What does this mean for a small business in Michigan? Let's say your business is an office environment and you have approximately 10 employees. Assume your business is 10 years old, and over that period of time you have acquired \$100,000 worth of office furniture, computers and other equipment. This would typically result in a true cash value for property tax purposes of approximately \$50,000. The resulting personal property tax due for that company would be in excess of \$1,000. By simply filing the Affidavit of Exemption by February 10, you will not be subject to this tax.

The typical kinds of equipment found in a small business environment that would be subject to personal property tax are office furniture, computer equipment, phone systems, copiers, equipment to manufacture and assemble your product, shelving, cash registers, cooking equipment, tables and chairs, etc. Other than inventory and supplies, if it is not attached to the building and you can take it with you, it is subject to the personal property tax.

Now for the details, in order to comply with these regulations, you must meet ALL of the following requirements:

- The personal property must be classified as industrial or commercial property.
- The property cannot be leased to or used by a person that previously owned the property.
- The combined True Cash Value is less than \$80,000. This includes property that is owned, leased or in your possession.

This is a great opportunity to save money for your business. The Affidavit of Exemption from Personal Property Tax Exemption must be filed by **February 10**. Please contact your tax professional with questions.
