Overview:

A Project Architect will act as the project development lead or part of a designated team to execute thoughtful, site responsive projects which remain focused on the end-user and their experience of space. The Project Architect will embody the design ethos of INFORM and contribute to the production, coordination and development of projects from design concept through construction administration. As a multidisciplinary design firm, this person will work in close association with the interior design, urban design and engineering disciplines on a wide variety of project types. The Project Architect will also be responsible to mentor less experienced staff that are pursuing licensure and demonstrating best practice methods as an example to teach. The Project Architect will also be responsible to collaborate with the project manager to ensure the project manager can be effective in delivering all aspects of the professional services obligation.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Lead or contribute to the development of projects from pre-design through project completion by establishing and meeting project goals, developing visually compelling presentations and documentation for all phases of design, and monitoring work during construction; in order to complete the project with respect to budget and schedule.
- Collaborate with all disciplines to ensure comprehensive design solutions are achieved and communicate design aspirations clearly to the entire project team, client, and key stakeholders with both visual and verbal communication skills.
- Provide design solutions that align with goals and minimize risk with a sensitivity to design quality and direction.
- Ensure that all aspects of code and life safety issues are addressed throughout the entire design process and coordinate with teams and external consultants.
- Provide leadership and mentoring to less experienced staff.
